Animal Licensing

The Hoyt Lakes City Council adopted Ordinance No. 229, “An Ordinance Repealing and Replacing Section 90.03 of the Hoyt Lakes City Code Regarding Requirements for License of Animals” on November 8, 2021.

This changes the two-year registration requirement for animal licenses. After the current license expires, animal owners will be required to purchase either a lifetime or annual license. Fees will be determined by City Council and are dependent on if the animal is altered (spayed or neutered). Proof of rabies vaccination within 3 years for a dog and within 2 years for a cat will continue to be required at time of application.
