Paul Cherry form SLC's Assessor's office presented the Sales Book and recited an excerpt from the letter to the members of the city which states "During the 2025 sales study period there were 24 "arm's length" transactions within the City of Hoyt Lakes. The Minnesota Department of Revenue requires a median sales ratio of no less than 90% and no more than 105%. The sales ratio prior to any changes was 84.1%. Analysis of the sales ratios resulted in the following changes for the 2025 assessment, Taxes payable 2026. Following these changes, the sale ratio is now at 95.3%."

One resident of the community was present to request a reduction to his property valuation (208 Cambridge) and expressed concerns about rising home valuations, rising taxes and the affordability of seniors living in Hoyt Lakes.
