CITY OF HOYT LAKES, MINNESOTA RESOLUTION NO. 2025-014 A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE MAYORAL DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, On May 15, 2025, Mayor Brennan Scott of the City of Hoyt Lakes declared a local emergency pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 12.29, in response to a wildfire threatening the City's municipal boundaries and public safety; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of Hoyt Lakes subsequently extended the duration of that local emergency through resolution, enabling the City to coordinate emergency response, access resources, and implement contingency measures; and

WHEREAS, Conditions necessitating the continuation of the local emergency have subsided, the immediate threat to the public has been mitigated, and normal operations have resumed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota:

- 1. The local emergency initially declared on May 15, 2025, is hereby terminated effective as of Monday, June 9, 2025.
- 2. All extraordinary powers and emergency measures exercised under that declaration are rescinded as of that date.
- 3. The City Administrator is directed to notify relevant agencies and ensure that the termination of the local emergency is properly recorded and communicated to the public.
