Resolution 2026-005**

A Resolution of Support and Authorization for the
Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) Regional Trailhead Pavilion Project

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes supports the grant application to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources for funding through the Federal Recreational Trails Program (RTP) to restore and repurpose the historic 1939 Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) Pavilion at Colby Lake in Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota, into a regional recreational trailhead and trail-support facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes recognizes the Rajala Woods Foundation, a Minnesota-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, as the owner and steward of the CCC Pavilion property, and acknowledges the Foundation's commitment to partner on this project by supporting restoration efforts, long-term stewardship, and coordination with public and nonprofit partners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hoyt Lakes acknowledges that the project requires a minimum twenty-five percent (25%) local matching share and confirms that local matching funds have been secured for this project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that if the City of Hoyt Lakes is awarded a grant by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, the City agrees to accept the grant award and enter into a grant agreement with the State of Minnesota for the above-referenced project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Hoyt Lakes agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws, rules, environmental requirements, and regulations as stated in the grant agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Hoyt Lakes certifies it has read the Conflict-of-Interest Policy contained in the Trail Program Grant Manual and agrees to report any actual, potential, or organizational conflicts of interest upon discovery to the State related to the application or grant award; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hoyt Lakes designates the following representatives for this project:
